

Welcome to the 18th Annual
Bostwick Cotton Gin Festival
Saturday, November 3, 2007
9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Each year the City of Bostwick sponsors a festival to raise money for the continuing restoration of the Susie Agnes Hotel. The hotel was built in 1902 by the founder of Bostwick, John Bostwick, Sr. Bostwick is a small farming town with a rare operating cotton gin, cotton fields and a lot of tractors. Bostwick is located in Morgan County on Highway 83 between Madison and Monroe, Walton County. Please join us as we celebrate our history. Time: Saturday set-up begins at 6:00 a.m. Vendors must be completely set-up for viewing by 8:30 a.m. **All vehicles must be out of exhibit area.** There will be vendor parking near the festival. There will be no Friday set-up for reasons of security and safety. All vendors must remain until 5:00 p.m. on Saturday.

Booth Fee: Art and craft vendor fee is \$65.00, children activity vendor fee is \$75.00 and food vendor fee is \$100.00. Electricity (15 watts per vendor) is limited and is only used for food vendors at no extra cost. Vendor must provide any and all cords.

Eligible Exhibit Items: Vendors must exhibit original, creative, handmade, quality arts and crafts unless pre-approved by festival. Please contact festival in writing for pre-approval.

Booth Space: Total booth size for exhibitors is 10' x 10'. Food vendor space is 10' x 15'. The size of space for children activities will vary depending on the activity. Tents are required and must be stabilized. The acceptance notice will indicate the terrain.

Application Process: Application deadline is July 1st. **Three current photos (one of booth set-up and two of craft) and the fee should be mailed with application. Applications mailed without photographs will be returned; no exceptions.** (Food vendors must submit a menu). Notification of festival acceptance and unaccepted applications (and fee) will be returned by August 1st. Non-acceptances will not be confirmed or discussed by phone. If you receive a non-acceptance letter, you may write the festival for the reason you were denied entry. The festival committee reserves the right to decline exhibitors that do not meet the expectation of quality and attractiveness of display indicated in photos. **The committee assumes no responsibility for accidents, loss or damage to persons or property at anytime during the festival.
